The Main Idea: Hold it High. Guard it Well. Pass it On

Discussion Questions:

- Read 2 Timothy 1:13-18. Jot down what stands out to you.
- In verse 13, Paul spoke of a “pattern of sound teaching,” how do we not just put the words of God to memory but to “Internalize” it?
- Read Isaiah 40:8, Matthew 24:35, 2 Timothy 3:15-17, Psalm 22:26; 23:6; 49:7-9; Ecclesiastes 12:7; Daniel 12:2-3; Matthew 25:46, 1 Corinthians 15:12-19, Revelation 21-22, Daniel 12:2, Matthew 25:31-46. What do these passages tell us of what “two things” that will last forever? Why is that important to believe?
- Agree or disagree with this statement. “Courage is not possible apart from Strong Biblical Convictions”
- Read John 14:16–17, Acts 1:8, 1 Cor. 3:16; 6:19, John 16:13. What do these passages teach us about the Holy Spirit?
- Read 2 Timothy 1:15, 1 Corinthians 15:33. Paul had many people betray him throughout his ministry. How has betrayal affected you? Agree or disagree with this statement: “There is and will be betrayal in the church, but that does not mean betrayal is the church”
- Onesiphorus name means “Profit bringer.” He was true friend to Paul in his time of need. Who are the Onesiphorus’ in your life? How can you let them know what they have meant to you?

Action:

- How secure is the deposit of truth with you? In what way can you make it more secure? In what ways can you guard it?
- How do you:
 - Become a Student of the Word of God
 - Surround yourself with people of strong biblical convictions
 - Actively defend the truth in faith and with love
