2 Timothy 4:1-5 Part 10 Participants Guide – 2 Timothy Series

<u>The Main Idea</u>: You have been Called, Commissioned, and will be held Accountable. Hold the Truth High, Guard the Truth from the Lies and Pass it on.

Discussion Questions:

- Read through the book of 2 Timothy 4:1-5. Jot down what stands out to you.
- Read 2 Timothy 4:1, James 3:1, Ephesians 2:10. Why is the 'charge' so heavy? How does the truth of you being Judged, not for your sins but for your walk affect you? Read 1 Corinthians 3:10-15
- Agree or disagree? Everyone who have embraced Jesus as their Lord and Savior have been given a SOLOMN CHARGE.

You are his Workmanship/Masterpiece Created by Jesus Christ himself to do something good Which he had in mind before you were even born

- Read 2 Timothy 4:2, Jeremiah 20:9, 5:14, Acts 21:11–13, 1 Peter 3:15, Ephesians 5:15–16. How can we be ready "in season and out of season?' What do you think that means?
- Read 2 Timothy 4:2, 3:16-17. All Scripture, both Old and New Testament, is for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and Instructing.
 What does that tell you about the power of God's word.

Teaching: What we need to believe. Rebuke: When we are wrong. Correction: Getting us back on track Instruction: How we should live

Read 2 Timothy 4:3-4. What does Paul predict for the future and are you seeing this now?

"They want religious entertainment from Christian performers who will tickle their ears. We have a love for novelty in the churches today: emotional movies, pageants, foot—tapping music, colored lights, etc. The man who simply opens the Bible is rejected while the shallow religious entertainer becomes a celebrity. . . . the itching ears soon will become deaf ears as people turn away from the truth and believe man—made fables." Dr. Warren Wiersbe

 today?
- Read 2 Timothy 4:5, Titus 1:9. What does Paul encourage Timothy to do considering all this?
