The Main Idea: Hold it High. Guard it Well. Pass it On

Discussion Questions:

Read 2 Timothy 2:8-13. Write down what stands out to you.

What are we told to do in verse 8?

What are the specific things we are to bring to our minds (8)?

What does the word 'Christ' mean? Why is it used here?

Explain 'risen from the dead' in your own words?

Why might Paul call the gospel 'my gospel'?

Where you think Paul is as he writes this letter to Timothy? Why so?

Why is it important that as Paul says, "the word of God is not imprisoned"? (9)

Why does Paul endure suffering (10)? Was he like this before he became a believer? Explain.

• Think up three things you endure so that you can serve others.

Why is the salvation of others so important? Do you personally believe this? How do you know?

This group of verses was probably a standard church song. What do you note about it? How can this help us analyze the songs we sing? What are the purposes of church songs?

What makes a statement trustworthy?

What might it mean "if we died with Him"? (11)

What does it mean to live with Him (11)?

"If we endure, we will also reign with Him" in verse 12? Explain.

Explain in your own words what it means to endure.

What does it mean to disown Him?

Does "He also will disown us" mean we will not be saved, or we are not saved? Explain

Read John 10:27-29, John 14:2-3

If we are faithless, He remains faithful; for He cannot deny Himself" (13)

Can God be faithless? Why or why not? In what ways is it great that God is faithful?

Reflection:

- What is one thing that you face great difficulty enduring? Why?
- In what way can you fulfil God's purposes in your life?
