- Read Titus 3. What stands out to you in this passage?

Not only do they fail to appreciate the magnificence of the world they inhabit, they lack the capacity to recognize their own blindness to it.” – William Irwin Thompson

- Read Titus 3:1. How do you by subject to rulers and authorities when you disagree with them? . Why is it so important to have Good strong servant leadership in the Church?

- Read Titus 3:2. What specific ways does Paul urge kindness towards “All Men”?

- Read Titus 3:3-7, John 3:3-8, Romans 5:8. How does Paul show how the Trinty, God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit are involved in our salvation?

- Read Titus 3:8-15. What was Titus to stress and why?

NEXT STEPS:

The Lord chooses to involve people in His sacred work when he doesn't have to. God doesn't need us but choose to use us as a part of his plan.

- What wrong needs to be made right?
